Dear WGASC Instructors,

Last May at the WGASC business meeting, the membership voted to redefine the divisions of our Scholastic Regional A Classes. The original proposal was submitted as a possible remedy to strengthen and improve the effort to provide a positive and formative educational and competitive environment for the large number of units in these Regional classes.

Following the meeting, a directive was issued to define specific criteria/expectations for each regional class. This directive was completed by a panel appointed by WGASC President, Kevin Roberts.

As a result, the WGASC will trial a Regional A, Regional AA, and Regional AAA class during the 2012 season. The new Regional AAA class will combine the WGI Scholastic A criteria with a shortened competition time requirement.

When selecting the best fit for your individual unit/units, please refer to the new Regional class criteria/expectations. As I mentioned previously, the skill set and expectations are very specific for each individual classification, so it is imperative that instructors select classification with this knowledge in place.
